I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide equal employment opportunity for all applicants for Oshki Ogimaag Charter School (OOCs) employment and OOCs employees.

II. General Statement of Policy

- A. It is the policy of OOCs to provide equal employment opportunity for all applicants and employees. The school district does not unlawfully discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, disability, sexual orientation, age, family care leave status or veteran status. OOCs also makes reasonable accommodations for disabled employees.
- B. Oshki Ogimaag Charter School prohibits the harassment of any individual for any of the categories listed above. For information about the types of conduct that constitute impermissible harassment and the school district's internal procedures for addressing complaints of harassment, please refer to the school district's policy on harassment and violence.
- C. This policy applies to all areas of employment including hiring, discharge, promotion, compensation, facilities or privileges of employment.
- D. It is the responsibility of every school district employee to follow this policy.
- E. Any person having any questions regarding this policy should discuss it with the director.
